

BALMY BEACH WINS WAR CANOE EVENTS

Also Captures International Four Trophy at Annual Regatta on Saturday

With perfect water conditions and a crowd of over three thousand to cheer them, the Balmy Beach paddlers turned on the speed and won both war canoe races at their regatta on Saturday. The home paddlers also won the International Four Trophy in decisive fashion with Nurse's crew leading Toronto Canoe Club by over two lengths.

The senior war canoe race was won by Balmy Beach over Parkdale, with Toronto in third place. This race was marred by a peculiar decision on the part of Aubrey Ireland, the referee, who ordered the race re-run after the crews were on shore and dressed. He said Parkdale were interfered with, and he did not pull his gun at the time as he figured it would not affect the finish.
