Win Eight of Eleven Events to Take Regatta Honors

Balmy Beach paddlers made a very impressive showing at their local regatta Saturday, winning eight of the eleven events carded to give them regatta honors. A slight roll on the water proved advantageous to the boys from the Beach, as they easily outdistanced their rivals in the tricky paddling.

In the first race of the afternoon, the intermediate singles, Harvey Charters started the Blue and Gold on its triumphant march, winning handily from Jack Redpath of Parkdale. From then on the Beachers flashed across the finishing line ahead of their fellow-bladesmen with monotonous regularity. They finally concluded the day with a first and second place victory in the senior war canoe event. Parkdale finished a hang-up third.

Gordon Sale garnered the only five points for Island Aquatic when he beat the veteran Roy Nurse in the senior singles. Nurse appeared to have victory certain, only to lose control of his boat in the rough water. L. Quackenbush put on a finishing spurt to take down second place for Parkdale Canoe Club. Harvey Charters was a good third.

In the point standing, Balmy Beach amassed a total of 48 points to give them a margin of 26 points over their nearest rivals, Parkdale, who had 22 to their credit. Toronto was third with 10 points and Island Aquatic finished up with 7. A well-attended community dance in the evening concluded a very busy afternoon.
