

ISLAND CANOE CLUB WINS BEACH REGATTA HONORS

Paddlers of the Island Canoe Club swept to victory with an aggregate of 33 points at the Balmy Beach Canoe Club regatta Saturday afternoon. It was the Island club's second triumph in the week, because previously they annexed honors at their own Dominion Day club regatta.

The old gold and blue colors of the host club, Balmy Beach, showed in the winner's circle enough to claim second place with 22 points, well ahead of Kitchener and Toronto Sailing and Canoe Club, tied with five points each. Boulevard managed only a single point. Points were based on five for a first, two for second and one for third.

Terry Evans, the Toronto fireman who paddles for Kitchener Canoe Club, won the featured singles event without great trouble. At the finish line Evans had about twenty yards of open water between his craft and that of Jack La Rose of the Island Club, who was second. Glen Thompson of the Island was in third spot.

Conditions were ideal for the meet. The waters of Lake Ontario were extremely calm, and a warm sun was tempered by a slight breeze.
